Maintenance Repair Workers Overview

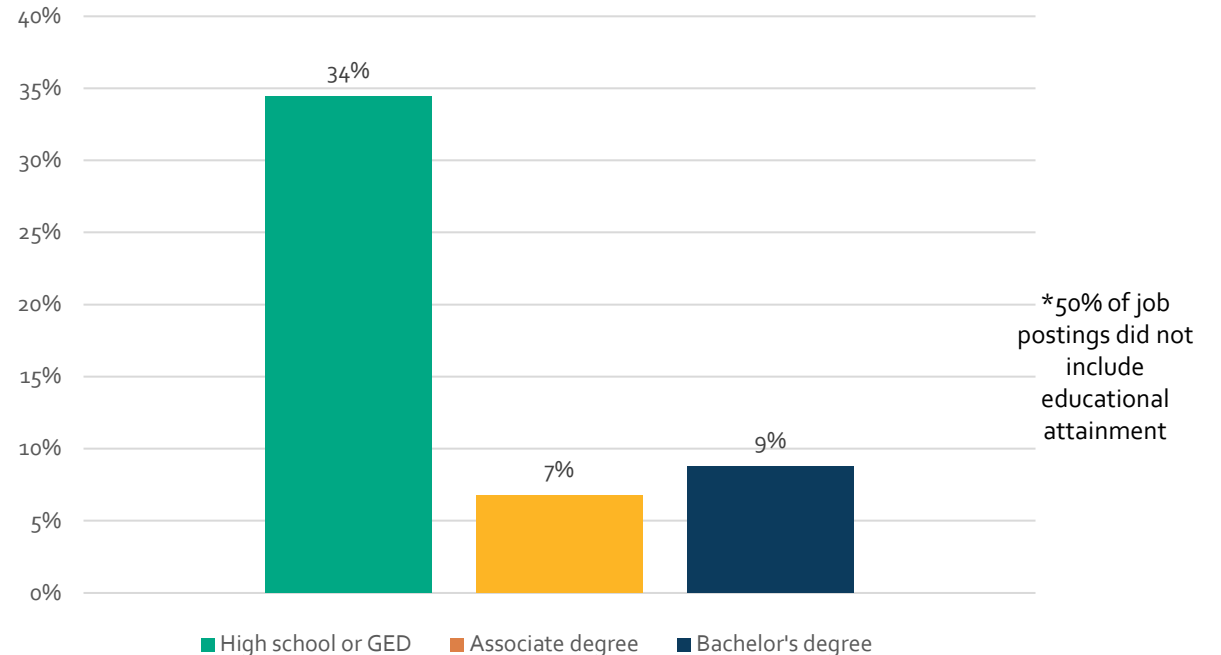

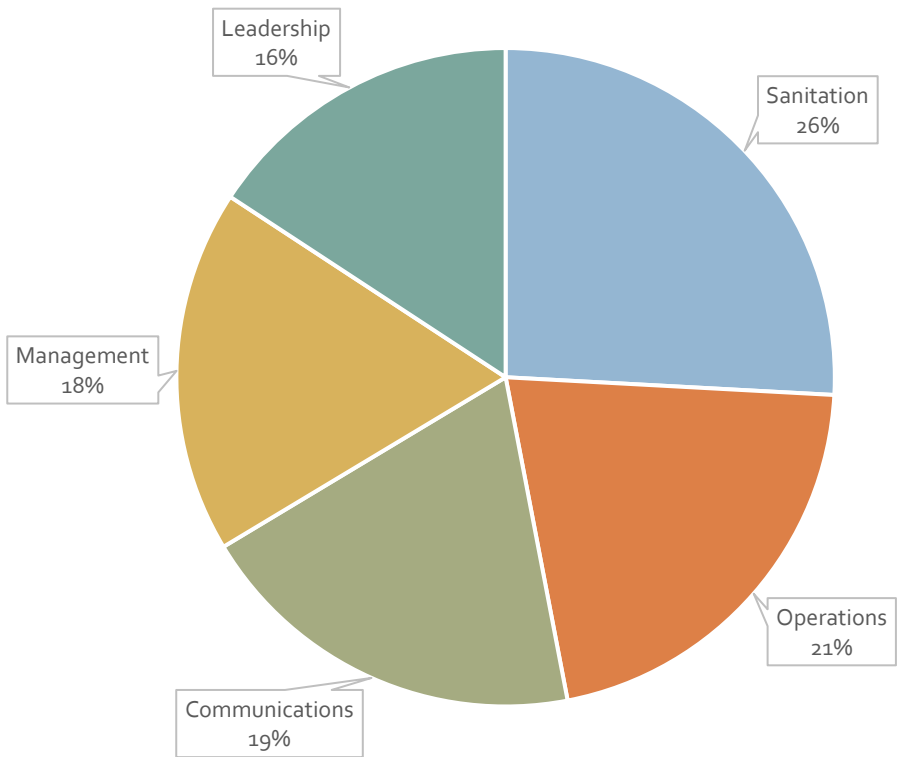
Education Breakdown



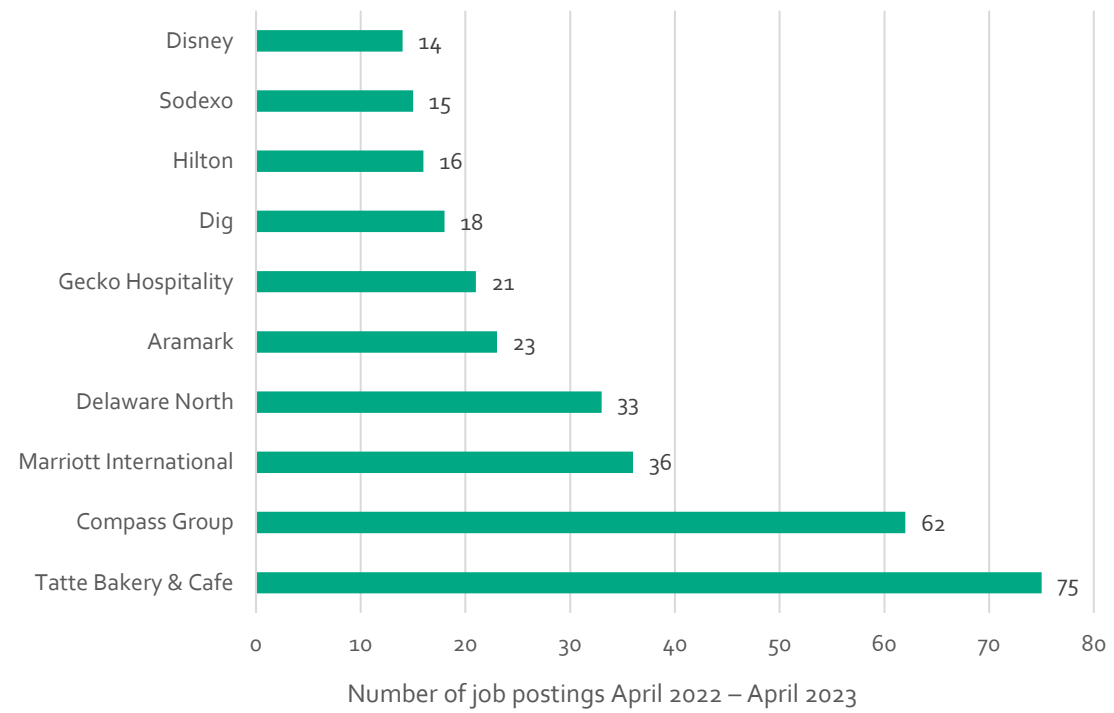
